Cancellation Charges

Individuals, who are unable to attend a course that has been confirmed, must cancel their booking via email (erscb.training@eastriding.gov.uk) as soon as they become aware of this. A substitute can take their place, but must be made known to the ERSCB training coordinator as soon as possible.

Cancellation charges will apply after a place has been confirmed if less than 5 working days' notice of cancellation is given prior to a course date.
